# **SHEEPDOG TRIAL TRADE STANDS** **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

All persons booking trade stand space, or exhibiting, or wishing to conduct business on the trial field (the Applicant) must read and agree to the following before completing the Trade Stand Form.

- 1 The International Sheep Dog Society (the Society) and the Highland Sheepdog Association (HSA), reserves the right to refuse any application without giving reason.
2. The Society, HSA, officials, organisers and workers, estate owner and employees (Society officials), will not be held responsible for the following:-
  - a) Any accident, damage or loss to the Applicant's or agents' person, goods, vehicles or property unless through direct act or negligence of a Society official.
  - b) Liability for any accident or damage arising from the actions of any person, goods, vehicles or property that should be under the control of the Applicant.
  - c) The security and safety of any exhibits, equipment, personal effects or tools brought or used by the Applicant or their agents.
  - d) Any consequential loss or expense that may arise as a result of any action or inaction on the part of the Society or Society official in connection with the event.
  - e) Any action, threat or damage from any person who is not a Society or HSA official.
3. The Applicant will indemnify the Society and HSA against all claims, damages or expenses arising in any way from the conduct or neglect of the Applicant or any employee, assistant, or instructed person (Agent) for whom they should be responsible.
4. In the event of a cancellation, postponement or abandonment due to reasons beyond the control of the Society, site fees NOT including deposits will only be refunded should cancellation be made more than 56 days before the event. Deposits will not be refunded under any circumstances.
5. Applicants and Agents must fulfil their responsibilities under Health and Safety Legislation with regard to their duties in connection with their activities towards themselves and others. Fire precautions on stands are the responsibility of the Applicant. Any Applicant intending to use compressed gas or hazardous materials on the days of the show is to notify the Local Secretary at the time of application
6. The Society and HSA reserve the right to require any Applicant or their Agent to modify their stand, apparatus, display or behaviour for any reason of safety or conduct not compatible with the event. Failure to take such action in good time will result in expulsion from the event without recourse to any refund. The decision of Society or HSA officials on such matters is final.
7. Business must be conducted within the designated space and any relocation can only be given in writing by an appointed Society or HSA official. No touting or business may be conducted outside the defined lines.
8. Where an Applicant cancels the space reserved for him for any reason, all fees paid will be forfeited and the organisers reserve the right to re-let the space.
9. Applicants are not permitted to sub let any part of the space allocated to them.
10. Please keep your own area clear of litter during and after the event. Refuse bins will be provided for the general public. Provision must be made by Applicants to dispose of trade litter. The organisers reserve the right to charge for reinstatement if the clearance of the site at the close of the event has not been carried out satisfactorily.
11. All trade stands must be ready for action by 9.00 am each day. No noise will be allowed after 8.00am that may upset competing dogs.
12. Applicants' vehicles displaying trade stand labels may be driven to and parked behind their allotted stand where space allows: Alternatively, in the official trade stand overflow car park. No vehicles may be moved about the site between 9.00 am and 5.30pm.
13. No food or drink for consumption on site may be sold, save by those with official permits.
14. No dog foods may be advertised, displayed or sold except by written permission of the Society.
15. All trade stand holders will be listed in the Trials programme.
